

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE HOLLOW & YEARLINGS DROVE, BRIANTSPUDDLE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along part of THE HOLLOW & YEARLINGS DROVE, BRIANTSPUDDLE (in both directions), for a combined distance of approximately 375 metres. The Notice is needed to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on Monday 26th April 2021 and will remain in force for five days. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by Friday 30th April 2021.

This Notice will allow engineers carry out maintenance works on BT Openreach equipment, both underground and overhead.

Alternative routes will be sign posted, as indicated by the blue line on the map below.
