

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF YEARLINGS DROVE, BRIANTSPUDDLE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Yearlings Drive, Briantspuddle between Throop Hollow and Throop Heath Road (in both directions), a distance of approximately 830 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 23rd May 2022 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 27th May 2022.

**This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to build chambers and install cables.**

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is indicated by the blue line on the map below.
